Students of Oncology from any stream related to oncology (medical, surgical, radiation, preventive, pathology, palliative, laboratory, basic science, etc) are eligible for participation in the Best Thesis competition. The thesis topic MUST be related to oncology substantially (decision of the committee regarding this shall be final and binding to all applicants).

<u>Benefits of qualifying for the best thesis competition (for all applicants whose application is accepted for entry into the competition)</u>

- 1. This is in addition to the prize for the final winner(s).
- 2. Complementary ICON membership for one year
- 3. Help with improving your publication manuscript once your final manuscript is ready, you can send it to us and we will assign a mentor who can suggest on how the manuscript can be improved prior to submitting to any journal.
- Priority for speedy review and possible publication if you choose to submit your manuscript (of thesis or any other one article) to one of the following Indian journals -Indian Journal of Medical and Pediatric Oncology (IJMPO), South Asian Journal of Cancer (SAJC), Indian Journal of Molecular and Immuno Oncology (IJMIO) and Indian Journal of Medical Sciences (IJMS).
- 5. We allow participants to present updated data on same thesis/ topic at other conferences abroad (eg ASCO/ ESMO/ IASLC, etc). Presentation at our conference will give you an opportunity to improve your abstract and anticipate questions so that you can incorporate those changes and do a better job elsewhere.

Participants will be divided into following categories:

- 1. Basic non medical Degree: (upto MSc or equivalent including nursing).
- 2. Non medical advanced degree: PhD in any subject.
- 3. Basic specialty degree: MD/ DNB in any subject (eg Radiation Therapy/ Medicine/ Pediatric/ Surgery, etc) or equivalent.
- 4. Super specialty degree: DM/ DNB in Medical Oncology/ Hematology * MCh/ DNB in Surgical Oncology or equivalent.

Qualifying Round (at 38th ICON Conference): 23rd March 2018 (poster presentation) Final Round (at 38th ICON Conference): 25th March 2018 (oral presentation max 10 mins)

- 2. Submitted to authorities for completion of degree requirements on or after 1st March 2016 (ie. Approximately last two years).

If I am found to be eligible, I know that I have to attend 38th ICON Conference and participate in the Qualifying Round on 23rd March 2018 by participating with a poster representing my thesis work.

I also know that **if I am shortlisted**, I have to participate in the Final Round on 25th March 2018, for which I will have to be ready with an oral ppt presentation (max 8 slides; max 10 minutes).

I know that I have to **apply separately to Dr Boben Thomas, Organizing Chairperson** of 38th ICON Conference for registration and travel grant (Rs 5,000/- available for limited applicants only).
